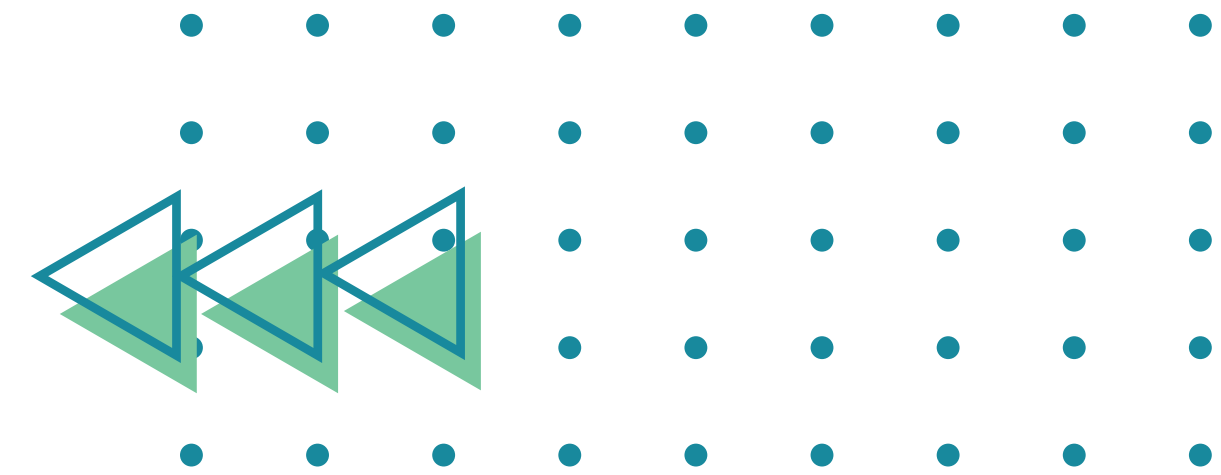


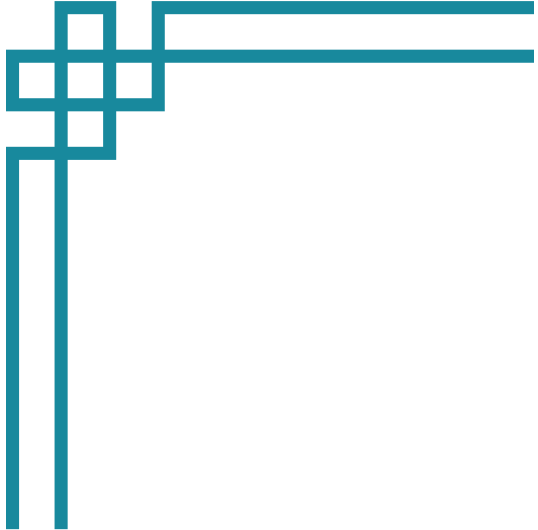


HOW MUCH CABIN BAGGAGE CAN YOU CARRY ON EGYPTAIR?

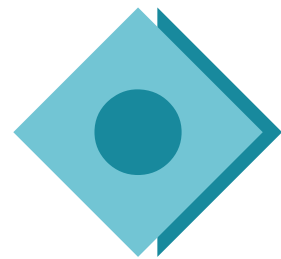

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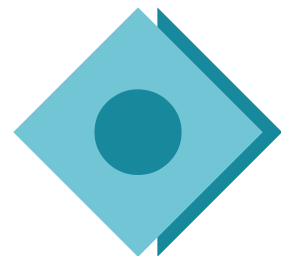




OVERVIEW OF EGYPTAIR CABIN BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE



EgyptAir cabin baggage allowance varies by travel class. Economy class passengers are permitted 1 piece of cabin baggage weighing up to 8kg (17.6 lbs), with maximum dimensions of 50x40x20 cm. Business class passengers enjoy a more generous allowance of 2 pieces of cabin baggage, each up to 8kg, with the same dimension limits per piece.



In addition to your cabin baggage, all passengers may carry one personal item such as a handbag, laptop bag, or small backpack. Please note that restrictions apply to liquids and gels — containers must not exceed 100ml and must be placed in a single transparent, resealable bag. Prohibited items including sharp objects and flammable materials are not permitted in the cabin.

ECONOMY CLASS CABIN BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE

1 Piece of Cabin Baggage Allowed

Economy class passengers on EgyptAir are permitted to bring one (1) piece of cabin baggage on board. This single bag must comply with EgyptAir's size and weight restrictions to be accepted in the overhead compartment.

Maximum Weight & Dimensions

Your cabin bag must not exceed 8 kg (17.6 lbs) in weight. The maximum allowed dimensions are 50 x 40 x 20 cm. Bags exceeding these limits may be required to be checked in at the passenger's expense.

Personal Item Also Permitted

In addition to your one cabin bag, Economy class passengers may carry one personal item such as a handbag, laptop bag, or small backpack. This item should fit under the seat in front of you and does not count toward your cabin baggage allowance.

BUSINESS CLASS CABIN BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE



2 pieces of cabin baggage allowed per passenger. Each piece may weigh up to 8kg (17.6 lbs). Maximum dimensions per piece: 50x40x20 cm.

A personal item (handbag, laptop bag, or small backpack) is also permitted in addition to the 2 cabin baggage pieces. Ensure each bag meets weight and size limits before boarding.

Tip: Distribute weight evenly across both bags to stay within the 8kg limit per piece. Business class passengers enjoy greater flexibility with double the carry-on allowance compared to Economy class.

PERSONAL ITEMS & RESTRICTIONS

Allowed personal items you may carry in addition to your cabin baggage allowance:

- Handbag
- Laptop bag
- Small backpack

These items must fit under the seat in front of you and do not count toward your main cabin baggage piece.

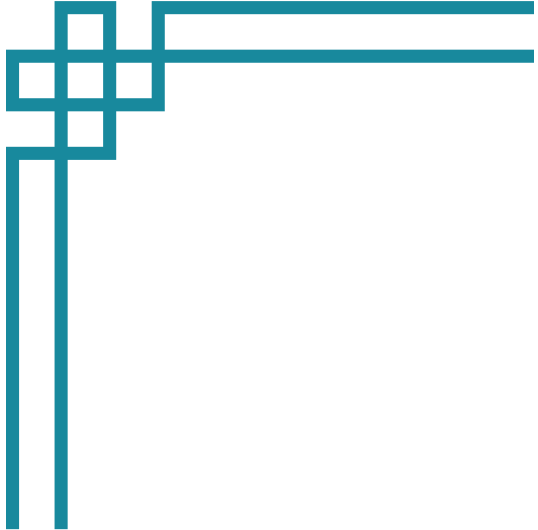
Liquids & Gels Rule: All containers must be 100ml or less, placed in one transparent, resealable plastic bag (max 1 litre capacity).
Prohibited Items: Sharp objects (knives, scissors), flammable materials, and other dangerous goods are strictly not permitted in cabin baggage. Check EgyptAir's official policy for the full list.



SPECIAL ITEMS: LAPTOPS, CAMERAS & DUTY-FREE



- Laptops and cameras may be carried on board in addition to your standard EgyptAir cabin baggage allowance — they do not count toward your 1-piece Economy or 2-piece Business limit.
 - Place laptops in an easily accessible pocket, as security will require you to remove them separately during screening.
 - Cameras and electronic accessories should be packed to allow quick removal if requested by security staff.

- Duty-free purchases made at the airport or on board are permitted, but must either fit within your existing cabin baggage allowance or be carried as an additional separate bag.
 - Keep duty-free receipts accessible in case staff need to verify purchases at boarding.
 - Ensure all duty-free liquids over 100ml are sealed in the original tamper-evident bag provided by the retailer to comply with security regulations.



TIPS FOR MAXIMIZING YOUR EGYPTAIR CABIN BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE



Use lightweight, soft-sided bags to save weight. Pack items tightly to maximize space inside your bag. Wear heavier clothing on board to reduce bag weight and stay within EgyptAir's 8kg cabin baggage limit.

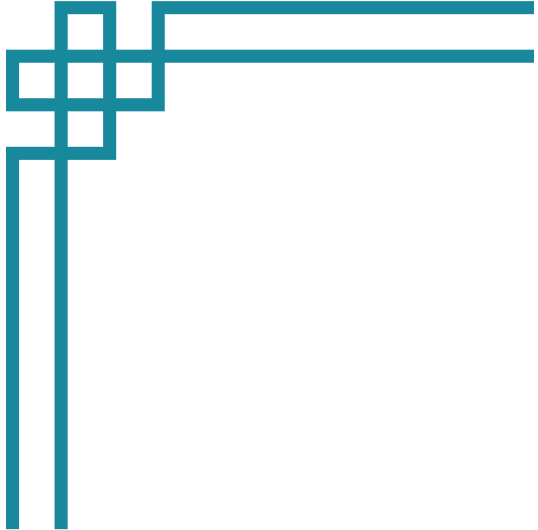


Use your personal item allowance wisely — a laptop bag or small backpack counts as your personal item and can carry extra essentials without affecting your main cabin baggage allowance.

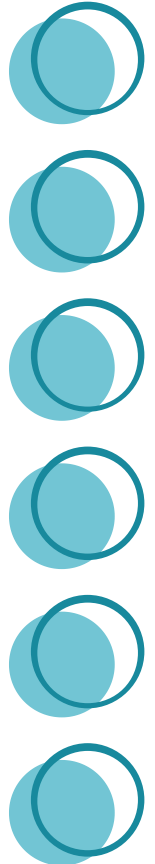
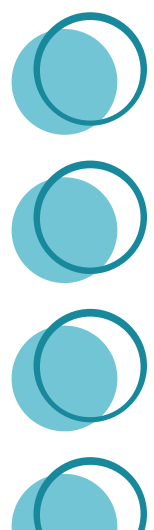


Follow liquid restrictions carefully: containers must be no more than 100ml each, placed in one transparent resealable bag. This avoids security delays and ensures a smooth boarding experience.



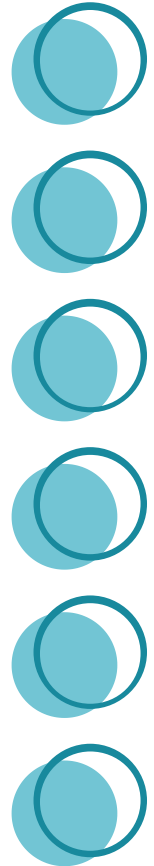


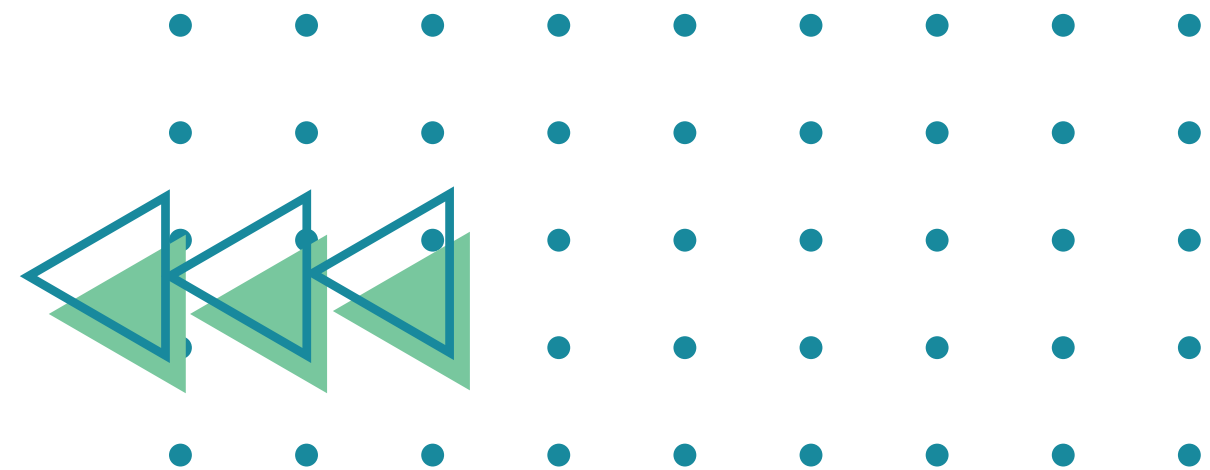
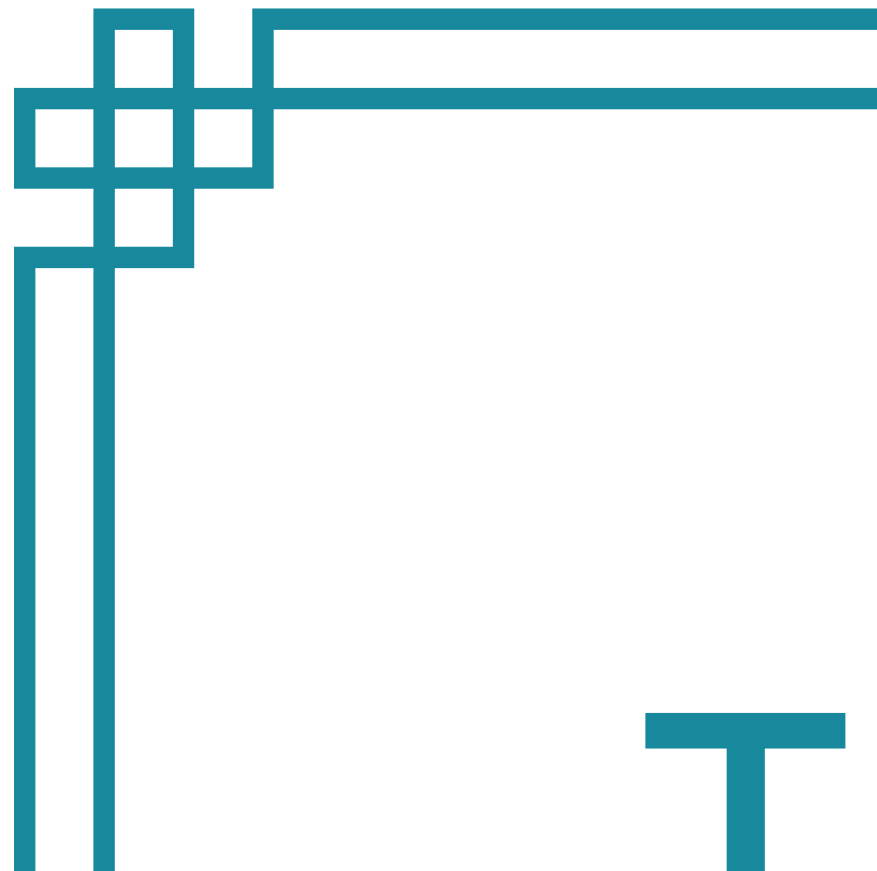
CONSEQUENCES OF EXCEEDING EGYPTAIR CABIN BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE



Overweight or oversized cabin baggage may be checked in at the passenger's expense. Additional fees will apply, and the amount can vary depending on the route and fare class. To avoid unexpected charges, always weigh and measure your bags before heading to the airport.

Exceeding cabin baggage limits can cause boarding delays for you and fellow passengers. Security and gate staff may require re-packing or check-in of oversized items. Plan ahead — weigh your bags at home and ensure dimensions do not exceed 50x40x20 cm to travel stress-free.
