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Homeowners notice the difference between a rushed job and a careful one

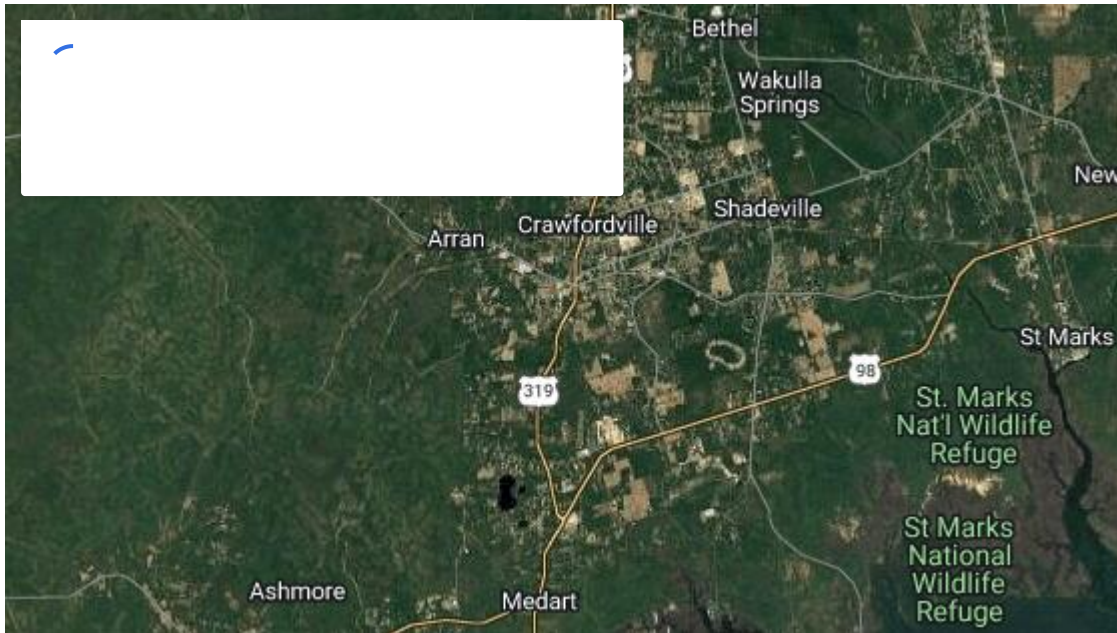
What homeowners usually appreciate after the job is done
